DRIVING TO CONDITIONS & SHARING THE ROAD

The Council of the R.M. of Louise would like to strongly encourage motorists to watch their speed, drive to conditions and share the road. Gravel roads present their own special road safety challenges. Construction material, placement of windrows, weather, traffic volumes and vehicle weights can change a gravel road's condition very quickly.

Please be reminded that the maximum speed for an unposted road is 90 km for ideal conditions – dry, stable roads and good visibility. As weather or road conditions deteriorate, your speed should decrease.

Any speed that endangers people, property or safety is prohibited and a driver must use a speed that is reasonable and prudent for the conditions. This means always keep the safety of yourself and others in mind when driving and be aware of all posted warning signs.

When driving, you can expect to share the road with other vehicles, agricultural equipment, people, and even animals. It is every driver's responsibility to share the road safely.

Please evaluate your driving habits on a regular basis and pay attention to road conditions and the safety of people, animals and property.
